The Marex 310 Sun Cruiser is a sophisticated and innovative family cruiser. Being the 5th generation of the Marex Sun Cruiser concept, it embodies years of perfecting the details and practicality, implementing the wishes from previous customers to create an optimal 31-foot family boat. She has a planning hull with a large inside volume to create comfort and plenty of storage. The 310 has won many awards, including Motorboat of the Year, European Powerboat of the Year and the German Design Award for its timeless design, functionality and providing safety for the family.







Social and liveable

It is the perfect boat for cruising with four people. It is designed to deliver the ideal combination of comfort and space for your family and friends.

The 310 Sun Cruiser features a spacious combined cockpit/salon area, which lets you enjoy a day cruising with up to 10 people. The forward-facing co-pilot seating lets you accompany the captain during cruising. Sit or lay comfortably at the extensive seating around a large folding table. You can lower the dining table and easily convert the benches into a perfect sunbathing bed or extra sleeping place.





Open spaces

Swim platform

The swim platform benches are set to become your favourite place to relax on sunny days. The very large storage lockers beneath are made for 6 to 8 fenders, mooring equipment, fishing gear, and toys. A hatch hides the comfortable bathing ladder to give you more platform space.

Foredeck

Wide sidewalks with high handrails lead safely to the spacious foredeck. The closed-foam sun mattress is floating and can be thrown overboard as a water toy for fun and play. An opening in the rails also provides easy access to land.

Three-season boat

The surprisingly large social area is made for sun and relaxation. All family members can equally appreciate the sofas and seats with remarkable comfort. The concept facilitates joy and fun in the sun. The 310 SC offers great flexibility in more chilly weather via the quickest enclosure, which can be pulled out from the side lockers within a few seconds. The sliding sunroofs over the cockpit can be opened or fixed in several positions, providing shading and shielding from wind or temperature protection. A standard heater gives you enjoyment in the colder days.














Seamless Layout

The galley and cockpit are connected in a social and complementary way. This allows the chef to cook while connecting with the rest of the guests in the cockpit.

An innovative galley is equipped with a sink, oven, gas hob, and many storage systems, while the 140-litre fridge and freezer are hidden under the pilot and co-pilot seats. Solar roof panels make it possible to use them for long periods far away from shore power. A large open roof provides a feeling of openness and lets all cooking fumes out. A see-through sliding door allows you to close off and lock the cabins.

The two cabins below the deck are furnished with two spacious double beds. Large hull windows provide natural light and the feeling of space. Guests will have high on-board comfort thanks to a large, well-finished bathroom. Choose your style and colour scheme among the numerous natural materials. 
Reliability and Performance

A planing hull provides family cruising in the range of 25 to 28 knots and can be equipped with a single sterndrive, starting from a single Volvo Penta 320 up to a 440 hp diesel. Having produced over 700 of our earlier Sun Cruiser models, you can trust our experienced installations. The 310 Sun Cruiser features an ergonomic helm for standing and sitting and an inviting double helms seat. The captain's position provides an excellent overview of the surroundings during navigation and still be social with the family.
